BroadWay aims that the PCP will trigger innovative solutions to be developed and tested to address the following challenge: R&D to develop pan-European interoperable mobile broadband for public safety, improve collaboration between responders from different agencies/countries and enable the mobility of responders between different agencies/countries.

II.2.4) Description of the procurement: <i>(nature and quantity of works, supplies or services or indication of needs and requirements)</i> This pre-commercial procurement (PCP) is a Horizon 2020-funded collaboration of parties called BroadWay. BroadWay is comprised of Public Safety Communication Europe (PSCE www.psc-europe.eu), ASTRID (www.astrid.be) and a group of Europe-based procurers (as listed in 1.1) that are either nationally responsible for public safety or are public safety responders, who face the same challenges and seek similar solutions. ASTRID is the lead procurer and all information regarding this PCP can be found on the project website - http://www.broadway-info.eu/ . BroadWay aspires to have innovative solutions developed and tested to address the common challenges they share in inter alia cases of industrial or natural disasters, serious traffic accidents, terrorist attacks and social conflicts, where a lack of PPDR roaming/interoperability renders communication between rescue teams from different countries extremely difficult. BroadWay proposes to launch a call for competition to select the most innovative and capable operators to develop new solutions for pan-European operational mobility. It will take the form of a pre-commercial procurement (PCP) under which R&D service contracts will be awarded to a number of operators in parallel in a phased approach. This will make it possible to compare competing alternative solutions. Each selected operator will be awarded a framework agreement that covers 3 R&D phases. The 3 phases are: 1) Solution design 2) Prototyping 3) Original development and validation and testing of a limited set of first products or services. After each phase, intermediate evaluations will be carried out to progressively select the best of the competing solutions. The operators with the best solutions will be offered a specific contract for the next phase. Testing and evaluation is expected to take place across multiple locations with key input from first responder practitioners. It will take the form of realistic cross-border and cross-organizational scenarios. The PCP procedure is estimated to end in December 2021. The successful solutions would become the first point of reference for pan-European interoperable broadband for public safety across at least 11 buying countries i.e. the lead procurer and the group of procurers. BroadWay wishes to undertake an open market consultation (OMC) to provide further information on its objectives, process, timescales and to seek feedback about the maturity of technology and capability of operators to innovate in this field. All interested operators are therefore invited to take part in the OMC regardless of their geographic location, the size or governance structure of their organization. It will not bind operators going forward. BroadWay expects to organize the OMC as an assortment of the following activities: – an Online Questionnaire (early July), – face to face meetings, in Belgian Federal Police HQ Brussels on – Tentative: 13.09.2018 – Tentative: 18.09.2018 – Online webinar on tentative: 20.07. & 09.08.2018 – and finally an Online Q&A forum, where questions will be answered within 3-5 days. BroadWay will manage the OMC process in an open and transparent manner and all OMC activities, such as dates, venues, registration, background information and key outputs will be published on the project website from early July 2018 onwards - http://www.broadway-info.eu/ .
